Ø <u>Associated Members</u> are administrative units, regions, associations, schools, planning agencies, etc.


ELSA currently includes




largest of the nine federal provinces (19,200 km²)


covers almost one quarter of the surface area of Austria





Wetland soils correspond with areas of flooding.


