L'ambiente con i suoi livelli d'acqua differenziati offre vaste possibilità di sosta durante i passi migratori, di svernamento e di riproduzione a specie quali numerosi anatidi, l'airone cenerino, la nitticora, la garzetta, la sterna comune, il cavaliere d'Italia, il beccaccino, il piro piro piccolo, il piro piro cul bianco e il corriere piccolo. Inoltre il fiume Secchia rappresenta un importante asse migratorio che comporta il passaggio di specie rare come la cicogna nera, che ha sostato più volte all'interno dell'area.
