Company presentation and site visit

The ILPA Group is a manufacturer of thermoformed plastic food packaging.

The synergies created in fact by its three divisions, allow ILPA to completely manage the supply chain of rPET with the control of the entire recycling process, starting with the material post consumption up to the following stages of selection, washing, grinding, extrusion and thermoforming of food packaging in r-PET.

We will visit also the plant for the recovery of the pet from the separate waste collection, and production of r-PET films with a 3-layer structure where the two exteriors use virgin PET while the inner one (at least 80% by weight) consists of Recycled PET.

The ILPA Group in 2016 produced 18,000 tons of recycled material, helping to avoid producing the same amount of virgin PET.

From Guglielmo Marconi International Airport to Bologna City Center or Bologna Central Station use bus line “BLQ”.


It takes about 20 minutes by bus to reach the Central Station. Taxi are located at the airport exit.


